(A) Hauptli, B. (2014). *Lecture Supplement on Dewey's Experience and Nature*.

Bruce Hauptli has offered a course on *Experience and Nature* (PHH3700 Homepage). The lecture supplement studies *Experience and Nature* chapter by chapter. It raised critical discussion questions as well.
